

3. After you register on FACTS with your child(ren), TBS will enter the tuition amount(s) into your account through FACTS.
4. If you have applied for and received financial aid for tuition, that aid will be entered into the system by the TBS staff.
5. On the FACTS website, you will be able to choose your payment plan, and you will then receive electronic invoices from FACTS.

After completing the initial year's financial arrangements through FACTS:

1. You will receive an electronic student *renewal* registration form for your family. This form includes student information, placement requests and other information.
2. If your information is the same as last year, please indicate that on the form and you will not need to complete additional information other than placement requests.
