As we are all starting to adjust to our new reality, I wanted to send an update on the status of our building closure. The security, health and safety of our entire TBS community remain our top priority. With that in mind, after consultation with various medical professionals, we made the decision to close our building last Friday, March 13. We made this decision to close, even before the local school districts made their own decisions to close, because we felt it was the right thing to do.

Our messaging last Friday stated that TBS will remain closed for the next two weeks and that we would continue to monitor the situation. It's safe to say that our closure will last beyond March 27, and we simply don't know for how long. We will continue to monitor the situation and we will continue to keep you updated on any new developments.

In the meantime, we hope that you are enjoying our virtual offerings that our clergy and educators are working hard to provide. We will continue to provide you with relevant programs, and we will continue to be socially connected, physically distant, and spiritually close.

In terms of the physical building, this week I have met with the Cherry Hill Police Department and the Federation's newly hired Regional Security Director to ensure that our building is monitored frequently during the closure.

Cleaning crews are here this week and have been working hard to thoroughly clean, sanitize and disinfect the building, and wall mounted hand sanitizers have been installed throughout the building.
