What can the money be used for? Any authorized trip to Israel of ten days or more.

Please note: Gift of Israel funds are intended to cover a portion of the cost of an Israel program. Prices of Israel programs vary.

Who is eligible? Members of a participating synagogue with children enrolled in Jewish education through 10th grade.

How much and how often do I pay? You can enroll your child as early as Kindergarten and as late as 6th grade. You make deposits each year (up to 7 years) – and each deposit is matched.

How and when do I pay? Deposits are made online each year or may be paid upfront.

Is there a fee? There is a ONE TIME, non-refundable enrollment fee of \$50 payable to the Jewish Federation of Southern NJ.

How is the money managed? The money is held in an account with the Jewish Federation. Statements will be emailed annually showing how much is in your child's account. **NOTE: Your money is fully refundable at any time!**

What about going to Israel on Birthright? Your child can participate in a transformative confirmation trip to Israel offered by our community and still be eligible to do a Birthright trip.

FACT SHEET

- Gift of Israel (GOI) is a cooperative savings program in which families, synagogues, and the Jewish Federation of Southern New Jersey join together to provide funds toward educational programs in Israel for participating students.
- Authorized trips include: any peer program of ten days or more, such as a Confirmation or teen summer trip, a semester of college study in Israel or a young adult Israel program. Funds must be used by age 23.

- Children must be enrolled in Jewish education through 10th grade, and the family <u>must</u> also remain members in good standing of a participating synagogue to receive the matching contributions for the duration of the enrollment. Family must also be in good standing with the Jewish Federation of Southern NJ.
- *The family deposits \$300 in the first year (grades K-3 only) and up to \$250 each year after, via an online payment to Jewish Federation of Southern NJ. Families may deposit more than \$250 per year, but only the minimum deposit is eligible for the match. Families can make deposits toward their child's account for 7 years or until 9th grade, whichever comes first.
- ► A \$50 one-time, non-refundable registration fee is required for each child.
- If a family withdraws from the program, the family is refunded the monies they have deposited to date. The matching funds are forfeited.
- The family's contribution is managed in a secure bank account by the Jewish Federation of Southern New Jersey, and synagogue funds are deposited in accounts administered by the Jewish Community Foundation, Inc., a supporting organization of the Jewish Federation of Southern NJ.
