SCENARIO 1 – COVID POSITIVE

Student has received a **positive COVID-19 test result**

STUDENT NEEDS TO ISOLATE FOR AT LEAST 5 DAYS.

- If student has no symptoms or symptoms are resolving after at least 5 days of isolation, they may return to TBS, wearing a mask through Day 10, when:
 - 1. they have been fever-free without the use of fever-reducing medication for at least 24 hours; and
 - 2. they have tested negative with a COVID-19 rapid antigen test administered on or after Day 6.
- Please contact the Education Department when your student tests positive so we can help calculate the isolation period.

SCENARIO 2 – COVID EXPOSURE

Student has come into close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19

STUDENT MAY CONTINUE TO ATTEND SCHOOL.

- Student may continue to attend school as long as they remain asymptomatic. Parents must monitor student for symptoms or fever.
- Student must wear a mask at school through Day 10 (10 days from last exposure). Student may remove mask when eating/drinking.
