Scheduled for last spring, it had to be postponed because of the pandemic. Our speaker, Dr. Rafael Medoff, agreed to reschedule. We didn't know when we will be able to have him come in person so we proposed to him the idea of his sharing his expertise via Zoom. We are pleased to have a new format for the Klein Weekend this year. – Dr. Medoff will present the original program over four consecutive Saturday evenings in February via Zoom. Dr. Medoff is founding director of The David S. Wyman Institute for Holocaust Studies, based in Washington, D.C., which focuses on America's response to Nazism and the Holocaust. He has taught Jewish history at Ohio State University, Purchase College (SUNY), served as associate editor of the scholarly journal *American Jewish History*, and contributed to the *Encyclopedia Judaica*. He is the author of more than 20 books on the Holocaust, Zionism, and American Jewish history, the latest of which is *The Jews Should Keep Quiet: Franklin D. Roosevelt, Rabbi Stephen S. Wise, and the Holocaust*.
