Burial Plot (for Traditional and/or Cremated Remains Interment)

Purchased through the Temple only.

Casket

Required for traditional burial

Washtenong does not sell caskets. May be purchased through funeral home or other vendor. Costs vary widely depending on type.

Plain Casket: \$1,000-\$2,000

Vaults

Required for both traditional casket burial and a small vault (urn) for cremation remains interment.

May be purchased through Washtenong, funeral home, or other vendor. Check with Washtenong office for required sizes and specifications. Cemetery allows bottomless vaults for a traditional burial. Discuss with Rabbi if desired. Approximate Washtenong Costs:

For Traditional Burial

Basic Concrete Vault: \$1,600 includes tax and installation

Basic Concrete Bottomless Vault: \$1,400 includes tax and installation

For Cremation Interment

Basic Concrete Box (unlined): \$675 includes tax and installation

Other Urn Types: \$800 - \$1,800 includes tax and installation

Opening & Closing

Required (Includes tent & family chairs set up)

Second or Third Burial in Same Lot

Optional

Washtenong Cemetery, Rabbi Whinston, and Temple Policy permit multiple interments in one traditional lot as indicated below. This allows spouse, partner and/or family members who wish to be interred together but may differ on interment preferences. Also saves cost and land resources.

Allowed in one lot:

- One traditional full casket burial plus one or two cremated remains
- Up to three cremated remains

Additional Costs for multiple interments:

- Paid directly to cemetery for each subsequent interment (called 2nd or 3rd "Right").
- Cost: 50% of Cemetery's current lot cost in Beth Emeth Garden.
- Will require a new "Certificate of Interment" from Washtenong for each subsequent interment if not paid at time of original purchase.
- Opening & closing costs in effect at the time of each subsequent interment also apply.
- Contact the Washtenong office for questions on multiple interments.

Memorial Marker

- Required by one year.
- All memorials are flat, in-ground.
- No vertical headstones permitted in Beth Emeth section.
- Family is responsible for purchasing and installation costs. Not purchased through the Temple.

Washtenong Cemetery offers a 10% discount for memorial markers purchased through Washtenong for burials in Beth Emeth section. Must be requested at time of order. See "TBE/Washtenong Rules & Regulations" document on TBE Website or consult with Washtenong office staff for details.

Memorial Markers may be purchased through Washtenong, funeral home, outside vendor, or internet but must be installed by Washtenong and conform with Washtenong strict size and appearance specifications & requirements.

Verify with cemetery office before you purchase from an outside source. Many different styles, colors and formats are available. Prices vary by style, color, size, wording, engraving selected. Additional costs for Hebrew lettering and or symbols as desired. May be a single memorial size for one burial or double (companion) style over two adjoining graves. See samples on TBE website or from source you are purchasing from.

Shepard hooks for hanging plants or flower baskets are not permitted nor are glass or ceramic vases or other objects such as shells, statues, pictures etc. permitted on graves. Small "visitor stones" may be placed on the memorial marker. Refer to the TBE/Washtenong "Decoration Policy" on the TBE website regarding flowers and other graveside restrictions.
