


FRS KINDERGARTEN ADMISSIONS & ELIGIBILITY POLICY

1. In order to qualify for admission to the Kindergarten children must be at least two years old.
2. Priority for places will be awarded as follows:-
 - a) Children of FRS members where the entire eligible family unit has chosen to join FRS.
 - b) Children of FRS members where the entire eligible family has not chosen to join FRS.
 - c) Children of FRS Friends (as defined by the Constitution / Draft Articles of Association of FRS).
 - d) Siblings of past pupils.
 - e) Children whose parents belong to another synagogue.
 - f) Children whose parents belong to any other faiths or none.
3. Parents that are interested in making an application for the Kindergarten will be invited to visit and will be shown around by the Headteacher or Deputy Headteacher. This visit can be booked by telephone on 020 8445 6807. A prospectus, application form and relevant information will be handed to the parents during the visit.
4. Reservations for places for children in priority 2a above will be accepted on a first come first served basis. Applications must be secured by payment of a £250 deposit. If places are available this will be confirmed in writing within two weeks of application and then this deposit will then become non-refundable but deducted from the child's last term's fees at the Kindergarten.
5. Applications for places for children in priority 2b & 2c can be made after visiting the Kindergarten. (See 3 above) An application form, together with an application fee of £250 is required. The child's name will be placed on a waiting list and places will be allocated two terms before the child is due to start.
6. Applications for places for children in priority 2d can be made after visiting the Kindergarten. (See 3 above) An application form, together with an application fee of £250 is required. The child's name will be placed on a waiting list and places will be allocated one term before the child is due to start. Once all places are allocated in accordance with the above any remaining places will be allocated for priority 2e.

7. Successful applications will receive written notice of the child's start date and a full term's fees will then be payable in order to secure the place. Unsuccessful applicants will have the £250 application fee refunded before the term that the child was registered for.

8. Places awarded to any child may be reviewed in the event that the criteria they were awarded a place under ceases to apply.
