



Keeping everyone safe at The Liberal Jewish Synagogue during the High Holy Days 5782/2021

Our first priority is to keep everyone safe and reassure everyone who attends by minimising any risk of an outbreak of COVID-19.

- Please do not come to the synagogue if you have any **symptoms or are unwell**. If you are unsure, we encourage you to **seek medical advice** before you come.
- Maintain a **safe distance** from others when you move around in the building, when you come in and as you leave.
- Please use **hand sanitiser** when entering and leaving the building.
- We suggest that you check-in on the **NHS COVID-19 app** if you can; we will also be keeping a list of everyone who attends (this information will be held at the synagogue for no longer than 21 days, when it will be securely destroyed).
- Follow the **one-way system** around the synagogue and the **signs and directions** from LJS volunteer members.
- Please wear a **face covering** at all times while you are in the building, unless medically exempt.
- Keep **outer clothing** with you at all times (use adjacent seats) and do not bring any **bags** larger than a handbag; the cloakrooms are currently closed.
- Do not use **mobile phones** to make calls anywhere within the building.
- Please bring your own **Machzor, kippah and tallit**. Prayers will be projected on to the wall to the side of the Ark so you can follow along.
- We encourage you to **join in with the prayers and singing**, though still wearing your face covering.
- Feel free to carry **water bottles** into the Sanctuary (except on Yom Kippur) to prevent dehydration.
- If you use the **toilet** during services or go out for a break, please wear your face covering, and sanitise your hands when entering and leaving.
- For security, **disperse quickly** from the forecourt and do not socialise.

Please adhere to the rules for the safety of the entire congregation. Further information will be provided with your tickets. Thank you.
