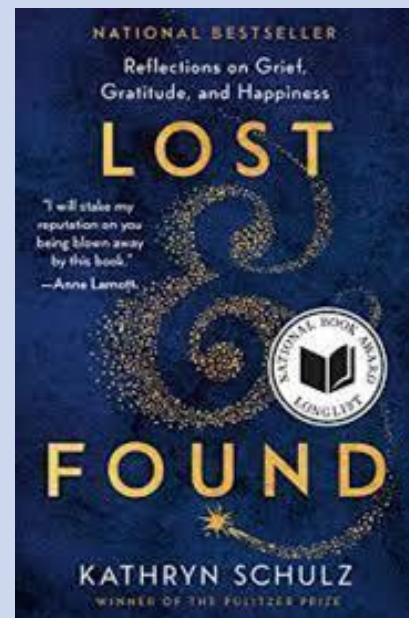

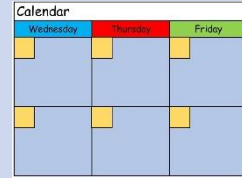
MIZPAH BOOK CLUB
