#### NEWS FROM THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

When the Board of Trustees gathered for the June board meeting, we welcomed many new faces. In an attempt to have the structure of our Board and Executive Committee better reflect our membership, more women and younger members were welcomed. The effects of this change have

already resulted in the development of some programming designed to engage a younger generation and their parents with the upcoming "Back-2-Shul" event on August 26th. It will be a Saturday morning service where many of the parts will be led by our youth. That includes doing some of the baking for the Kiddush luncheon following the service. What's better than being led in prayer by our youth, and then eating? Hopefully this can become an annual event that our members can look forward to. If you are curious, attend! What else are you doing that morning that is more interesting?

As far as the business of running the synagogue, we passed the annual budget. It is a balanced budget. A lot of planning, research, and input goes into the budget process. We are conservative in our revenue estimates, and aggressive in our estimates of expenditures. Over the last several years, this has allowed AJ to operate without using revenue from our endowment. This is not a small task. I hope that our members appreciate that we are a non-profit organization which has gone through a major renovation, is still renovating and improving the physical structure of the synagogue, survived a recession, is debtfree, provides a vast array of programming to our members as well as the Jewish and non-Jewish community as a whole, has a daily minyan and an award-winning preschool, and has national and internationally recognized clergy under lifetime contracts. We may not always be this fortunate, but the longer we put off having to use endowment funds for operations, and reinvest them and allow the endowment to grow, the chance for the congregation to sustain ourselves for future generations improves. AJ has been in existence for over 150 years. We won't let it fail on our watch.

Although we take these facts for granted, I'm not sure there are many other congregations, either locally or nationally, who can make similar statements. You are members of a first-class organization. Be proud of it, and take advantage of all it has to offer. Share with us your suggestions on how it can be even better.
