

Celebrate Father's Day at Adath Jeshurun with authentic New York Deli and a Movie!



NEWS FROM THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

A few final thoughts before I hand over the keys of the congregation to incoming President, Bill Esakov. It has been a great honor to be your president over the past three years, and I must say, for the most

part, everyone has been on their best behavior!

The synagogue is a vibrant, active place, humming with activities for everyone. It all starts with the daily minyan, something we should all be proud of, as this tradition is becoming rare in other synagogues. It is certainly unique in Louisville, and the envy of congregations nationwide. Our preschool is still educating and caring for our children, as well as children in the Highlands neighborhood. The AJ Preschool has been providing unparalleled excellence for many generations.

Bar/Bat mitzvah training, Melton classes, concerts, Passover seders, Louisville Orchestra performances, Back to Shul services led by youth, Deli with Dads, bris/babynamings, bar/bat mitzvahs, weddings, and funerals are just some of the occasions which give purpose to our facility. Not to be forgotten is the essential function of the synagogue, a place to get spiritually and emotionally refreshed via the guidance and wise counsel of our clergy. We end the day with the afternoon and evening service and occasional business meetings.

This activity goes on every day, and has been going on for over 150 years. It doesn't happen magically. The president and board members add their two cents for a few years, but the heavy lifting is accomplished by the full-time staff. Robin Silverman brings years of experience. She has seen and heard it all, and facilitates all aspects of the synagogue. Her help has been invaluable. Molly Evancho attends to the details of the building and all functions. The fact that a variety of ongoing programs and events occur with minimal issues is attributable to Molly's attention to detail. Speaking of which, we have a Financial Administrator, Holly Southwick, who is one of the most driven and precise people I have ever worked with. Holly is one of the reasons that the congregation is so financially-sound. She is instrumental in preparing our budget, which enables us to keep the lights on every year.

Deborah Slosberg provides a variety of adult education opportunities, including the very successful Louisville Melton program, which is exceptional and well-attended. Barb Embry, Laura Canfield, Belinda Lasch and Tina Benningfield all contribute greatly in their roles. They make everything come together, and we are very appreciative of all their hard work and efforts on behalf of the shul.

I've said it before, and it is worth repeating.... I think that our Rabbi and Cantor are second to none! We are very fortunate to have chosen wisely many years ago, and the marriage has worked out well. They have been rewarded with lifetime contracts, and we have been rewarded with clergy who have devoted their careers to making our congregation a leader in Jewish learning, culture, and ritual. Our continued success is largely due to their efforts.

Be proud of your congregation! It is a well-run organization that is holding its own during this period of changing demographics for all religious institutions, Jewish and non-Jewish alike.
