

CONTRACT FOR SPONSORING AN "IN-HOUSE" KIDDUSH LUNCH AT AJ



Thank you for sponsoring a Kiddush lunch at AJ! Kiddush lunches are prepared by our Food Service Coordinator, and feed a **maximum of 75 people** including congregational members who attend Shabbat services. The entire expected attendance during the Shabbat worship service must fit in the Yarmuth Family Chapel. If you are anticipating more than 75 people, or desiring **any** modifications to the kiddush lunch package, your needs can be met by hiring a caterer, and renting the auditorium and kitchen. This will ensure that there will be ample quantities and varieties of food and beverages which a catering staff is equipped to provide. Your tax-deductible contribution of \$375 will provide a sponsored Kiddush lunch. Lox is available for an additional fee. Please make your selections below, and return this contract with your payment to the AJ office at least two months prior to your event. ALL KIDDUSH LUNCHES INCLUDE THE ITEMS BELOW FOR \$375:

Assorted Desserts	Three plates of desserts
Bagels & Cream Cheese	Three-dozen bagels and three pounds of cream cheese
Casserole	Two chafing dishes of casserole
Challah	One challah loaf
Coffee	One pot of regular coffee and one pot of decaf coffee
Cold Beverage	Two pitchers of iced tea
Egg Salad	One bowl of egg salad (60 eggs)
Salad	One large bowl of tossed salad
Seasonal Fruit	400 ounces of fruit
Soup	400 ounces of soup
Tomato/Onion Platter	Eight tomatoes and one large onion
Tuna Salad	Eight pounds of tuna salad (made with two large cans of tuna)
Wine	One bottle of wine for kiddush

SPECIAL CELEBRATION CAKE

CANDY and/or NAPKINS

Kosher candy and/or colored paper napkins may be purchased by the member and provided to Molly Evancho to set out on the tables for the Kiddush lunch. All candy and/or napkins must be in the building before 4:00 p.m. on Friday afternoon.

DEVIATIONS FROM THIS CONTRACT

Other than a cake or candy as outlined above, **NO** additional items nor supplemental food may be brought in for the Kiddush lunch. Members desiring additional quantities, varieties, or any supplemental food (other than a cake, candy or the fish options below), will require an outside caterer rather than AJ's staff, along with rental of the auditorium and kitchen.

Adath Jeshurun's facilities are available to members in good standing who are current in their financial obligations to the synagogue.

- 1) **We will have slightly more than 75 guests in attendance. Will you make an exception, just this once?**
 We've had members pressuring our staff to make exceptions, and we kindly request that members refrain from doing this. Please understand that providing lunch for more than 75 people requires coordination and preparation by a catering staff.
- 2) **Can I supplement the Kiddush lunch with some extra food that I bring in, bake at AJ, or have delivered?**
 Kosher cake and candy are permitted. Members desiring to make extra food in the AJ kitchen, have different varieties, larger quantities of food, or any substitutions to our menu will need to hire a caterer, and rent the kitchen and auditorium.
- 3) **Can AJ provide catering for a small Bar/Bat Mitzvah Kiddush lunch?**
 AJ does not have a catering staff to handle this kind of event.
- 4) **Can I take home any left-over food from the Kiddush lunch which I am sponsoring?**
 Nothing may be removed from the building on Shabbat. Additionally, since the sponsorship of a Kiddush lunch is a tax-deductible gift, no goods or services may be received in exchange for your charitable contribution.
