Yahrzeit is observed on each anniversary of the day of death according to the Hebrew calendar. A yahrzeit candle should burn in the home during the twenty-four hour period of the yahrzeit, sunset to sunset. When the yahrzeit coincides with Shabbat or Yom Kippur, the yahrzeit candle should be lit before the Shabbat or Yom Kippur candles. When a yahrzeit begins on Saturday night or after Yom Kippur, the yahrzeit candle should not be lit until after Havdalah. Mourner's Kaddish is recited by the immediate relatives at all services on the yahrzeit. Please check the time for the daily minyan in the Synagogue Bulletin. As we cannot guarantee a minyan it is always advisable to bring friends and family with you to help make up the requisite ten adult Jews. If one is unable to recite Kaddish on the day of the yahrzeit, it is acceptable to do so at the Shabbat services proximate to that date. As is traditional at Beth Shalom, your loved one's name will be read from the bima at the service on Shabbat morning, prior to the day of the yahrzeit.
