Yom Hashoah Service, Monday, April 28, 7:00pm - Campus@5200 Our Commemoration this year will feature Chris Nicola, Speleologist & Cave Specialist, co-author of "The Secret of Priest's Grotto" and the documentary, "No Place on Earth", which tells the story of how a group of Jews survived the Holocaust by living in a cave for over a year. The Most Reverend Kevin C. Rhoades, Bishop of Fort Wayne-South Bend, will be presenting a special honor to a member of our community, Danuta Renk-Milulska. In July, 2013, Danuta was recognized in a ceremony at the Illinois Holocaust Museum & Education Center in Chicago, as **Righteous Among the Nations** for the role she and her parents played in rescuing Jews during the war. It is the highest honor that can be bestowed by the country of Israel.

People of the Book, Monday, May 5, 7:30pm - Campus @5200 Jane and Michael Stern drive around America looking for good food and exploring popular culture. Their collaboration has yielded over forty books, including the restaurant guide Roadfood, the cookbook Square Meals, the memoir Two for the Road and, most recently, 500 Things to Eat Before It's Too Late. In addition, they have written the pop-culture best-sellers Elvis World and The Encyclopedia of Bad Taste, and Michael Stern's Douglas Sirk. In 2006, Jane Stern's memoir, Ambulance Girl, was made into a Lifetime TV movie directed by and starring Kathy Bates. The Sterns write a monthly column about their discoveries in Gourmet magazine, contribute weekly to Public Radio's "The Splendid Table," and host the interactive website, Roadfood.com.
