Ner Tamid (Eternal Flame)

The tradition of a formal burial site has been in existence since Abraham insisted on purchasing the cave of Machpelah to bury Sarah (Genesis 23:12).

The establishment of the Ner Tamid Jewish Community Cemetery allows Jews and their immediate families to purchase plots in the Napa Valley for that purpose after 165 years here without such a place.

Policies have been established that adhere to Jewish guidelines for interment, services and symbols and may be obtained through the office of St. Helena Cemetery or Congregation Beth Shalom.

All plot purchases will be under the auspices of the St. Helena Cemetery and subject to its current general pricing.

Please note that a hand washing area is available at the end of Live Oak Avenue in a niche in the mausoleum closest to the office for those who wish to avail themselves of this tradition.

Ner Tamid Jewish Cemetery is administered by Congregation Beth Shalom a 501c3 a tax-exempt organization (ID: #23-7296339).

The congregation welcomes donations to help maintain this scared space.

The Ner Tamid (Eternal Flame) Jewish Community Cemetery is in reserved section 26 of the historic St. Helena Cemetery. The section is landscaped and demarcated from the larger community cemetery by attractive borders and a monument of specific Jewish significance. The Ner Tamid section is reserved for people of the Jewish faith and their immediate family, regardless of synagogue affiliation, and consists of 140 burial plots.

St. Helena Cemetery consists of 25 acres located in the heart of Napa Valley. Established as a private cemetery in 1856 by William Hudson, this non-profit cemetery has been under the quidance of a Board of Directors since 1872. The cemetery is a beautiful tree filled and tranquil park rich in California and local history. The passage of time has created a landscape where the lives of Napa Valley families and service veterans are commemorated.

Cemetery gates are open daily from dawn to dusk.
