

Food Policy

No pork or shellfish may be served at the Temple, either for Temple functions or when the building is loaned or rented for use by others.

At the Shabbat morning services, including B'nai Mitzvah luncheons and after minyan service potlucks, if meat is served, it shall be labeled as meat and placed on a separate table.

If you serve coffee, you must use Fair Trade Certified coffee (see www.fairtradeusa.org for more information).
