

Operations Update:

Temple Shalom Board of Directors has determined:

We will host in-person services, and provide livestream to YouTube, TS Facebook and access to Services and events.

Building Protocols (updated 9/24/21 and subject to change)

- **Registration online is expected** to participate at Temple Shalom. Those who register online do not need to check in or sign-in upon entry. Provide your name to the Officer on duty for admission. We continue to track participation for contact tracing. Registration should be submitted a full day prior to event/service start. Registration closes Friday at noon for Shabbat.
- IF you did not register, you must sign in at the table in the foyer. We continue to track participation for contact tracing--and have needed to use this valuable information.
- To protect those in our community who are most vulnerable, **Masks are required** for all participants 2 years and older at Temple Shalom. Your mask must be properly worn over your nose and mouth. Please step outdoors if you feel you need to remove your mask and take a break, and breath outside.
- Everyone entering the building may have their temperature taken. Normal temperature range is necessary to remain in the building. 95-100.4 Fahrenheit reads as 'normal temperature'.
- **Social Distancing is required and expected** for all participants. Seating by family pod, or social group is encouraged. Alternate rows and seats accordingly. Limited capacity.
- **No oneg or lunch.** Kiddush and Motzi will be grab and go -- outdoor patio.

Some additional Details:

- Advance registration online. Security Officer/BOD member will check-in participants.
- Doors open 15 minutes prior to services, close 30 minutes after start time.
- **Masks are required** for all those entering the building over age two.
- Worship will be held in the Taxman sanctuary. Other building areas are CLOSED.
- Social hall, kitchen, playground, lower level and classrooms remain closed.
- Entrance through the South Foyer (parking lot entrance) or Call AHEAD to let us know you wish to use the Monument St Ramp: 719-634-5311.
- Anyone with a temperature exceeding 100.4 degrees will be asked to return home.

- Children welcome to attend with parents provided they remain in the sanctuary.
- Restrooms in the foyer are open for use, cleaning supplies provided. (To wipe down faucet handles, doorknobs, etc.).
- BYO kippa/tallit if possible; BYO water bottle--water fountain available.
- No Onegs or Kiddush lunch. Kiddush and Motzi on the patio if weather permits.
