

Family School:

- We'll continue to gather as a community for musical and engaging tefilah and communal learning.
- Most weeks, children will have class by grade-level, including dedicated relationship-building time followed by meaningful, relevant curriculum, while parents pursue their own learning in Caffeine for the Brain. There will be some special sessions where families engage together in holiday celebrations, full-family learning, and social justice projects.
- Learners will continue to expand their knowledge of Hebrew through our word of the week, Hebrew Through Movement, and tefilah.

Hebrew School: 5th-7th Graders will continue to have two tracks for dedicated Hebrew learning

- Hebrew Class, 4:00-6:00pm on Thursdays: students will be assigned to a small group that meets from 4:00-4:45 OR 5:15-6:00pm. All students will come together from 4:45-5:15pm for tefilah.
- Private Hebrew Tutoring: students will have private tutoring for 30 minutes a week, in-person or online, at a time mutually agreed upon between the tutor and family.
- If your child will be in 6th or 7th grade, they should enroll in the SAME Hebrew track that they did this year.

The first day of Family School is September 10! At the end of the summer, we'll share more information about curriculum for each grade, supplemental experiences such as Simply Shabbat and youth groups, and a full calendar for the year.
