Re: DESIGN WORKSHOPS WILL ASK MEMBERS TO WEIGH IN ON RENOVATION SPECIFICS

We are so excited to begin the secular New Year with some significant progress on our renovation plan for Growing Where We're Planted!

On January 15th the Facility Task Force met with Tim Politis, our architect, and agreed that the next important step in our design process would be community input on specific aspects of the planning process. We will be scheduling Design Workshops in February and March about the following important aspects of the renovation plans:

1. Sanctuary design and acoustics
2. Sustainability and GREEN building
3. Learning: library and all spaces where children and adults learn
4. Security
5. Celebration: kitchen and open spaces
6. Outdoors: landscaping and children's play area
7. Access/inclusivity: all considerations throughout the building

Each meeting will last 1-2 hours and will support more concrete plans on how to implement the ideas that come out of each session. Members are invited to attend any/all of the workshops they are interested in.
