Food Vendors:

Attendees purchase food tickets. Food vendors, after event, will turn in their collected tickets to receive their portion of the proceeds.

All Vendors:

- Vendors may rent their tents from B'nai Havurah, or are welcome to bring their own tent, tables, chairs, and displays, and are asked to please remain within their allotted 10x10 area. Electrical outlets are available, but vendors are required to bring their own extension cords.
- Artist Vendors are asked to **track their sales** (you may use the form provided) and pay B'nai 15% of your proceeds from May 3, 2015. Please make checks payable to B'nai Havurah, or use your credit card through B'nai's Square payment processing account. Payments will be made at the close of the event.
- Booth fees are due no later than Wednesday April 22. Payment may be made through B'nai Havurah's website, www.bnaihavurah.org, or through Becky (call 303-388-4441.)
- Please submit a photo and brief business description or artist statement (included in Application) no later than Wednesday April 22 for inclusion in the program.
