Tikkun Olam



Tikun Olam awarded \$500 in July 2021 to the Second Wind Fund (SWF), a non-profit agency providing mental health services to youth (19 years of age and under) throughout 30 Colorado counties. These teens and pre-teens are experiencing mental health crises, often including suicidal ideation.

Even before the advent of COVID-19, suicide became the leading cause of death among Colorado youth. The pandemic also increased rates of anxiety, depression, and loneliness. Appropriate counseling is frequently unavailable due in exorbitant rates and/or few accessible facilities.

SWF reduces the financial barriers to receiving essential therapies by connecting youth with local professional providers at affordable rates. For more information, [click here](#) .
