The Parsha discusses the incredible actions of Pinchas with which he was zoche to Kehuna. The Gemara Sanhedrin 82a says that when Pinchas came to Moshe Rabbeinu, he asked isn't it muttar to be kann'a'in pog'in bo, to kill Zimri for what he is doing? Isn't this something you taught us when you came down from Har Sinai? If someone does what Zimri is doing, we are permitted to kill him. Asks the Gra on this Gemara, is it really logical that when Moshe Rabbeinu came down from Har Sinai, that this is the first lesson he had in mind to teach Klal Yisrael -- the rules of kann'a'in pog'in bo?

The Gra answers there are times that a Gadol B'yisrael decides to do something atypical or out of the ordinary. Sometimes, he needs to be bold enough to take matters into his own hands and act. It is not something an ordinary person can do, but what a leader can do. When Moshe Rabbeinu came down from Har Sinai and saw the Eigel, he shattered the Luchos. Hashem didn't command him to break the Luchos, as Rashi says; the Gemara Shabbos 87a says that Moshe Rabbeinu did it on his own. He said a kal v'chomer: if a Korban Pesach, which is one Mitzvah, a Mumar (one who rebels) is not allowed to partake in, then certainly by all 613 mitzvos of the Torah, a Mumar has no right to participate in. From that, Moshe Rabbeinu taught Klal Yisrael a halacha. When he came down from Har Sinai, he taught us there are times a leader must have the courage to do what needs to be done despite the fact it may not follow the general rules per se. For that, Pinchas learned there is a chibur, a connection, of the Jewish people with something inappropriate, kann'a'in pog'in bo.

Pinchas received Bris Kehunas Olam; Aharon Hakohen received it as well. When Klal Yisrael wanted to create an Eigel, they came to Aharon Hakohen and said make an Eigel for us. Rashi in Ki Sisa 32:5 says Aharon rationalized 'let me do it so that the anger is against me and not against them.' In other words, Aharon in his leadership capacity realized he had to make the Eigel to somehow deflect some of the criticism away from Klal Yisrael. Subsequently, Aharon became a Kohen. The simple understanding is that until the Eigel, the Bechorim would have been Kohanim. Aharon received Kehuna because he risked his own personal ruchnios for the benefit of Klal Yisrael. That is what Pinchas did. That is what Moshe did. It isn't a lesson for something we should do on our own generally, but a lesson in the leadership qualities of Manhigei Yisrael throughout the generations -- willing to sacrifice even their own ruchnios for the sake of Klal Yisrael.
