REMINDERS related to Tisha B'Av this weekend:

Shabbat davening -- No Pirkei Avot or Tzidkascha Tzedek this Shabbat.

Shabbat meals: Seudat Shelisheet is eaten at home, not in Shul. Eating stops at sunset. Zemirots, meat, and wine are permitted for all three meals. There is no formal seuda hamafsek before the fast. Rather, the fast begins at sundown on Shabbat. Guests are permitted on Shabbat, but many authorities restrict excess socializing, walks and guests at Seudat Shelisheet.

Motzei Shabbat: After sunset, shoes and chairs are permitted until borchu of Maariv. If one is home, shoes can be changed once the time that Shabbat concludes has arrived after saying borchu hamavdil bein kodsh l'chol". Only borei meorei haeish of havdala is recited on Saturday night.

Pregnancy: Since Tisha B'Av is a nidcheh this year, women who are pregnant need not fast. (If a baby is reliant on nursing, and it is difficult to fast, a nursing mother may also break her fast). However, havdala on beer or iced coffee without borei meorei haeish (if recited on Sunday) and besamim should be recited before eating.

Sunday night: Havdala of borei pri hagafen and hamavdil should be recited on Sunday night before eating. Meat and wine (except for havdala) are forbidden until Monday morning. Haircuts, music and laundry are permitted on Sunday night.

Have an easy and meaningful fast.
