If you are making a donation through the PayPal Giving Fund, please DO NOT check the box that the gift is being made anonymously. We need to be able to credit your account.

SETTING UP RECURRENT PAYMENTS

If you are interested in setting up a payment plan to automatically pay your membership, Building Fund, eruv, and mikveh obligations to Congregation Beth Aaron, just follow these easy steps:

- 4. Find where the page says "Pay this amount" and choose the number of payments you would like to make. You can set up the payment plan on a weekly, bi-weekly or monthly basis.
- 5. Click "continue to payment" and select whether you will pay the convenience fee.
