- 1. The hours of operation have been extended to 6:00 a.m to 6:00 p.m.
- Usage will be limited to one patron/family at a time, by making a reservation at <u>www.teaneckmikvah.com</u>. You are asked to sign up for only one 15-minute slot a day and do all of your pre-tevilah preparation (unwrapping, removing labels, etc.) at home to make the most efficient use of your time slot.
- 3. Please be respectful of other patrons and wait in your car until it is your time slot.
- 4. Please limit your time to your assigned 15-minute session.
- 5. Please refrain from congregating outside of the Mikvah.
