Good Erev Shabbos,

Spring must be in the air, as the past couple of weeks have seen a significant rise in Shabbos Shul attendance. We had a packed house in the Main Shul for Shacharit last week, and I apologize to anyone who we asked to move around to keep proper spacing. We will aim to better mark the seating sections to prevent confusion. But please remember:

IF YOU ARE DAVENING IN THE MAIN SHUL:

- You should only be sitting in a spot that has a "Please Sit Here" sign.
- Be sure to sit in a seat grouping that matches the seat grouping you signed up with. As an example, if you signed up for 1 seat, do not sit in a 3 seat group. If you do, you have just displaced 3 people.
- Kabbalat Shabbat: Both Ezras Nashim will be used for men's seating, and the book room will be used for women.
- Shabbos Shacharit: Both Ezras Nashim will be used for women's seating, and the book room will be used for men.

IF YOU ARE DAVENING IN THE SOCIAL HALL OR BEIT MIDRASH, OR IN THE BOOK ROOM:

- You should only be sitting in a set up seat.
- You should not move seats.
- You should be sure to sit in a seat grouping that matches the seat grouping you signed up with. See above example.

IF YOU ARE DAVENING AT AN OUTDOOR MINYAN:

- Be careful walking on slippery snow or ice
- Stay warm and dry
- Keep the faith... spring really will be here soon

THIS SHABBOS MORNING in particular will be especially crowded. We had to rearrange seats at the 7:15 Minyan to increase capacity, and added a 9:00 Minyan to carry overflow from the packed 8:45 Minyan. B"H it is great to see such a large turnout expected, but it is even more important to comply with the above noted seating guidelines so that we do not run out of space in our carefully laid out seating plans. Added Zachor Readings will further add to the shul occupancy, so please be mindful of our COVID guidelines for shul and outdoor minyan.

- · Masks must be worn at all times on premises, covering both mouth and nose
- Only sit in designated spots, and DO NOT move chairs around or find other seating or standing locations which will likely bring you within 6ft proximity of neighbors.
- Do not congregate in the lobby or common areas. When Shul is over, please exit the building. If you congregate outside shul, do so with masks and social distancing.
- <u>DO NOT</u> come to shul/minyan if you are feeling sick. While we all feel compelled to attend shul to hear Parshat Zachor, coming to shul while sick puts other members at risk, and is <u>ABSOLUTELY PROHIBITED</u>.

QUARANTINE GUIDELINES:

As many of us are aware, the CDC has changed its exposure induced quarantine regulations for non-symptomatic individuals who are between 2 weeks and 6 months from their second COVID vaccination. At this time, **Beth Aaron has not adopted that position, and still requires quarantine** for ANYONE directly exposed to a COVID infected person.

Also note that the NJ State guidelines for travel quarantine has not changed, and still remains in effect. As such, Beth Aaron still requires a 14 day quarantine period for ANY individual traveling outside of NJ/NY/CT/PA.

VIRTUAL DINNER & RAFFLE:
