Good Erev Shabbos,

Hopefully, you have had the opportunity to read the message we sent out last night regarding the growing concern with the resurgence of COVID cases both nationally and locally. While we do not have any plans at the moment to increase any specific safety measures, we did feel it appropriate to reinforce the adherence to the measures that have already been in place for the past few months.

With these safety measures in place, we have Baruch Hashem been able to keep our shul and membership safe, and have been able to protect against the risk of a shul wide quarantine should a member of a minyan test positive for the virus. Maintaining social distancing, wearing masks that firmly cover mouth and nose, maintaining cleanliness of hands, entering shul only if feeling well and not under any quarantine restriction, are critical pieces of this larger picture, as is our guideline of not permitting any singing inside of shul. We are therefore determined to continue promoting adherence to these safety guidelines, especially at this time of growing concern, and are relying on each of you to do your part to help make this achievable.

One concern that we've expressed in the past, which is even more relevant now, is for walk in traffic to shul, particularly on Sunday and weekday Mincha/Maariv. We understand that it is hard for us to turn away a fellow Jew looking to find a minyan or to say Kaddish, but it is important that we consider first and foremost the safety of our shul and our membership. We have set up a sign-up station in the lobby in front of the zmanim clock, with a paper sign-in sheet and a copy of the shul guidelines and waiver. If someone enters the shul for a minyan without previously signing up, please kindly ask them to read the guidelines and waiver, and to enter their complete information along with acknowledgement of the guidelines and waiver. Please welcome them appropriately, but also firmly communicate that they may NOT enter our shul without completing that information. If you do not feel comfortable approaching an individual, notify a gabbai, board member, or even the shul president, so that they can approach the individual. Once again, we are determined to continue promoting adherence to our safety guidelines, but rely on each of you to do your part to help make this achievable.
