

CONGREGATION DOR TIKVAH SHABBAT HOUSE INFORMATION

First, let me welcome you to Charleston and to the Dor Tikvah Shabbos House located at 1805 Sandcroft Drive Charleston, SC 29407. We are excited that you have chosen to spend Shabbos with us. Below is some helpful information about the house and Congregation Dor Tikvah. The code to enter the back door is C3579.

SHUL: Congregation Dor Tikvah davens across the street to the left of Addlestone Hebrew Academy at 1645 Wallenberg Blvd. Walk to the corner of Sandcroft Street and Wallenberg Blvd. Cross the street then turn left and walk approximately 200 feet. You will see it on the right. The shul is within the West Ashley Eruv and maintains a kosher kitchen facility. You can find times for services on our website at www.dortikvah.org.

DAVENING TIMES: Please visit www.dortikvah.org for davening times. Shabbos morning services begin at 9:00 a.m.

MEALS: We will try and find home hospitality for one or both Shabbos (Yom Tov) meals. In the event that we cannot find home hospitality (our bench of local Shomer Kashrut families is rather limited) you may purchase food from our local Kosher caterer, Marcie Rosenberg of Dining In, and eat your meals in the comfort of the Shabbos House. However, if eating in the Shabbos House is preferred, then utilizing the caterer is a viable option. NOTE: Dor Tikvah provides a Shabbos Kiddush after Shabbos morning services each week. On weeks where the shul has scheduled a Shabbos Academy Educational Weekend, this Kiddush is a much larger, usually dairy, Kiddush luncheon.

LIGHTS: The lamps in the living room are currently set on timers. Please make sure you turn on the light switches for the living room lamps prior to Shabbat. There are two switches that control outside lighting for the side and back of the house. The side lights are controlled by a switch located outside the Rabbi's office entrance. If you would like these lights on, please turn this grey switch on prior to Shabbat. The back door lights are controlled by a timer and should come on automatically.

KITCHEN: The kitchen is not operational for cooking full meals, but is functional for light meals such as cereal, bagels, etc. **All food must be approved by Rabbi Davies prior to bringing it into the house.** There is a coffee maker and a water urn. The water urn is simple to use. You merely need to fill it with water to the water line and plug it in. A red light will come on when the water is ready to serve. Please make sure you unplug the water urn prior to checking out of the house. You will find paper products, coffee, tea, etc. inside the kitchen cabinets.

CHECKING OUT: We ask that when you check out, please ensure all the lights are off and that you remove any food items that you brought into the house. **In addition, please remove all bed linens and towels from all beds used during your stay and place them in the laundry basket located in the bathroom. Please carry them down and start the washer on cold water.**

We are excited to host our welcomed guests, and though we do not charge for staying at the Shabbos House, we do suggest a recommended minimum donation of \$118. Donations can be made in several ways. Either on online at www.dortikvah.org , by mailing them to Congregation Dor Tikvah, PO Box 80301, Charleston, SC 29407, or by leaving money prior to your departure. Envelopes are located for your convenience in the front drawer by the microwave. They can be left in the clear plastic dividers outside the downstairs bathroom.
