

## **CONGREGATION DOR TIKVAH SHABBAT HOUSE INFORMATION**

We are excited that you have chosen to spend Shabbos with us. Below is some helpful information about the house and Congregation Dor Tikvah. *Please read carefully as we have made changes in the wake of the COVID-19 pandemic.*

**SHUL:** Congregation Dor Tikvah davens across the street from the House at 1645 Raoul Wallenberg Blvd. The shul is within the West Ashley Eruv and maintains a kosher kitchen facility.

**DAVENING TIMES:** You can find the times and protocol for services on our website at [www.dortikvah.org/services.html](http://www.dortikvah.org/services.html). **In-person Minyans are currently only held on Shabbat and holidays and require online registration.** The davening times for each week are also listed on our website in our [Calendar](#) and our Shabbat Newsletters, which you can find at <https://www.dortikvah.org/shabbatnl>.

**MEALS:** Home hospitality is currently unavailable due to social distancing restrictions. You may purchase food from our local kosher caterer, Marcie Rosenberg of Dining In Inc., and eat your meals in the comfort of the Shabbos House. **KITCHEN:** The kitchen is not operational for cooking full meals, but is functional for light meals such as cereal, bagels, etc. **All food must be approved by Rabbi Davies prior to bringing it into the house.** You can reach the Rabbi at [rabbi@dortikvah.org](mailto:rabbi@dortikvah.org). There is a coffee maker and a water urn.

**CHECKING OUT:** **To ensure the safety and health of all those who stay with us, we now require a \$120 cleaning fee.** We are excited to host our welcomed guests, and though we do not charge for the stay itself at the Shabbos House, we do suggest a recommended minimum donation of \$118.
