Competition Guidelines

This competition is an opportunity for local youth to explore the mandate of racial justice as an expression of Jewish values through a work of art. The contest is open to all Charleston-area Jewish youth in grades 6-12.

Submissions

Entries may be submitted in any number of formats (only one entry per participant):

- A written piece — poetry or prose
- Visual arts — painting, poster, drawing, sculpture, or mixed media
- Dramatic arts — monologue or play
- Music — original song

All entries must:

- Be the original work of the student
- Demonstrate a connection to Jewish text, historical moments, or personalities
- Convey a call to action around racial justice
- Be accompanied by a completed entry form

Submissions will be judged on their emotional power, clarity of message, artistic achievement, and adherence to entry guidelines.

Prizes

Winners of the competition will have the opportunity to direct cash donations to the charitable organizations of their choice.

Note: Prizes may be awarded as 1st, 2nd, and 3rd prizes among all entries or as equal prizes to different age categories, depending on the entries received. Total amount of prizes awarded will be \$3000.
