



## **KKBE Guidelines for Reopening & Resumption of Operations**

### **Phase 2: 7-day new case average 8 days before the event is between 312 and 1250.**

*Life cycle* events only (e.g. – Bnai' Mitzvah, weddings, conversions), limited to a maximum of 30 attendees plus staff and one musician in the sanctuary or 50 attendees plus staff and one musician in the courtyard, all having a negative COVID-19 test within 72 hours of event. Sanctuary should not be used more than once every 3 days to allow self-decontamination of surfaces, contents and prayer books. KKBE offices and building remain CLOSED to the public.

#### ***Attendee Requirements:***

- Self-screen before coming to KKBE for temperature greater than 99.5 degrees F, and any symptoms of COVID-19 infection. Should not attend if any of these are present.
- Use hand sanitizer upon entering the building.
- Wear a mask at all times when at the entrance/exit, in the building or the Courtyard (key participants are not required to wear masks during ceremony, but must maintain appropriate social distance when not wearing a mask).
- Sign attendance form with name, date and time when entering and exiting the building.
- Sign and date the Acknowledgment of Covid-19 Risks and Agreement to Follow KKBE Guidelines form, if not done previously.
- If attending an indoor event, proceed directly to the Sanctuary and do not congregate or socialize in the lobby or Social Hall
- Except for key participants, refrain from loud volume singing.

#### ***Additional Requirements – Courtyard, 50 participants:***

- No requirement for COVID-19 testing.
- Socially distance of 6 feet between individuals or family member groups (who have lived together in the same household for the past 72 hours) to be accomplished with proper placement of chairs.
- No entering the building except to use the rest rooms.
- Rabbi/s and key participants/family members to use Sanctuary portico with social distancing of 8 feet between non-family members.
- Separate sanitized microphones should be used for officiates and key participants.
- Others with Aliyah may come to front below the portico or remain in their seats.

Ushers designated by family, and approved by KKBE, to monitor attendee compliance with requirements.
