

Eruv Tavshilin

In order to be able to cook on Yom Tov for Shabbat we must prepare an Eruv Tavshilin before candle lighting of Yom Tov. One should set aside a complete roll or matzah and a cooked item that will last until shabbat (such as a hard boiled egg) for the Eruv Tavshilin. This food should be set aside and not eaten until Shabbat.

Hold the Eruv Tavshilin food in your hands and say:

בְּרוּךְ אַתָּה ה' אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם אֲשֶׁר קִדְּשָׁנוּ בְּמִצְוֹתָיו
וְצִוָּנוּ עַל מִצְוַת עֵרוּב.

Then make the following declaration:

בְּדִין עֵירוּבָא, יֵהָא שְׂרִי לָנָא לְאַפּוּיִי וּלְבִשּׁוּלִי וּלְאַטְמוּיִי
וּלְתַקּוּיִי (וּלְאַשְׁחוּטִי) וּלְאַדְלוּקִי שְׂרָגָא וּלְמַעֲבַד כָּל צְרָכָנָא
מִיּוֹם טוֹב לְשַׁבָּת.

“With this Eruv, we will be permitted to bake, and cook, and to cover foods to keep them warm, to arrange things, (to slaughter animals), to light flames from existing flames, and to make any preparations needed on Yom Tov for the purposes of Shabbat.”
