Teens can also be *Madrichim* (teen teaching assistants) on Sunday mornings. In this role, they can learn leadership skills, be role models for younger learners, and continue their relationship with the Kehal Kodesh community.

6TH GRADE EXPERIENCES

As our 6th graders begin preparing for their B'nei Mitzvah year, we are introducing two new components to their year of learning. Family Education for the 6th graders will be a Shabbaton, a Saturday Shabbat experience that will include Shabbat morning services, learning, lunch, and other interactive activities to learn more about the B'nei Mitzvah process. Also, the 6th graders will have an immersive mitzvah project curriculum called Mitzvah Corps. They will have opportunities to do several action projects during the year!
