The Beth Sholom B'nai Israel summer scholarship program has, as its goal, to award scholarships for participation in Jewish educational programs which meet certain religious and educational guidelines. These guidelines are:

- The program must have a substantial Jewish education component
- The laws of Shabbat and Kashrut must be observed.

The program must have a daily prayer component

The Scholarship Committee will review all applications, and the size of awards will depend on ability to pay, the number of requests, and the availability of funds. The committee must rely on its knowledge about the ability of the family to pay for the program, and may not be aware of particular circumstances. If there are any special circumstances or needs that you believe the committee should consider in determining the amount of the award for the applicant, please attach a detailed letter informing us of those needs. This information will be reviewed by a small subcommittee of the Scholarship Committee, and will be kept confidential.

Only children of members in good standing are eligible for scholarship awards.
