CHILDREN'S PROGRAMS

Tot Shabbat will run from 10:30-11:15am in the Berger Beit Midrash. The programming is geared for children between the ages of 0-4 and each child must be accompanied by an adult. Please join your children in groups for songs, tefillah, and fun!

Groups begin at 9:30a in four separate classrooms, with early babysitting available at 9:15a.

Alef: This group is designed for infants through three year olds. Parents are welcome to stay in this room or to drop off their child; there will be babysitters in this room to supervise the children who have been dropped off. There will be snacks and a Shabbat program; we ask that parents who opt to remain in this room with their child be respectful of the programming and the hard work of the babysitters.

Bet: This group is designed for kids in the two pre-school years prior to Kindergarten through Kindergarten. There will be games, snacks & davening.

Gimmel: This group is designed for kids in first, second and third grades. There will be davening, Parsha, games and snacks.

Dalet: This group is designed for kids in fourth grade through pre-bnei mitzvah. There will be davening, Parsha, games, and snacks.
