Dear Prospective Family,

We appreciate your interest in the Early Childhood Education Program (ECEP) at Temple Sinai. Our program includes classes for children from 18 months through 4-5 years of age, including our Summer Sensations camp program. These classes take place in our beautiful classrooms and newly-created outdoor play and learning spaces - our playground, our Mud Kitchen, our Art in Nature space, our Outdoor STEM center, our Construction space and our ECEP Amphitheater. Temple Sinai is situated in the historic Todd mansion, and that “homey” feeling is evident wherever you walk, both indoors and outdoors.

Choosing a program that fits your child’s and family’s needs is an important decision. At Temple Sinai’s ECEP, we understand that children are born with the curiosity, ability, and the desire to learn about their world and the people in it. Your child will be part of an active learning environment that will inspire creativity, imagination, and the love of learning! Equally important, you will become part of the Temple Sinai community, a community that is motivated to support the social, emotional, and academic journey that you are beginning with your child, as well as the Jewish journey that your family is beginning together. As an added benefit, Temple membership is **included** in full-year class tuition for those families whose oldest child is in Kindergarten or below. For those who are interested in membership and whose oldest child is in grade 1 or 2, Temple Sinai offers a reduced annual family membership rate.

Our program is a research-based program that incorporates the best practices from a variety of different educational approaches. We use both child-centered and teacher-guided instruction; our teachers design curriculum to teach developmentally appropriate skills based on themes that emerge during discussions and interactions. This type of “emergent” curriculum allows children with all learning styles to move through skills mastery at their own pace, using materials and activities that interest them. It also allows our educators to infuse Jewish values into the conversations in a way that makes them relevant for the children and their families. The lesson plans will differ from class to class and year to year, with the important age-level skills (social, cognitive, language, and physical) always at the core.

At this time, we are abiding by, or exceeding, all COVID-related health and safety guidelines set forth by the NJ State Office of Licensing, the NJ Department of Health and the Westfield Regional Health Department (our local health department). We are proud to share that these changes have been put in place in a way that is nearly invisible to the children in our program. They experience the same joy and excitement for learning that they always have. I am happy to answer any questions you may have.

Due to state licensing guidelines, visits to the school building and grounds must take place after all children are dismissed. Early Childhood Education Program Philosophy

At Temple Sinai's Early Childhood Education Program, we understand that children are born with the curiosity, ability, and desire to learn about their world and the people in it. CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

**** Below are the class offerings as planned for the 2021-2022 school year. These offerings are subject to change based on enrollment, staffing and licensing guidelines.**

Toddler Classes (page 4): Children ages 18 months to 2 years may attend our transition class on Tuesday and Thursday mornings from 9:00 – 11:00 am. (Contact us for information about our toddler-caregiver class for children ages 12 to 18 months.)

2s Classes (page 4): Children may attend three mornings (Monday, Wednesday and Friday), four mornings (Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday), or five mornings per week. Classes meet from 9:00 am – 12:00 noon, or from 9:00 am – 1:00 pm with the Lunch+Extended Day option. The 2s Lunch+Extended Day program begins several weeks into the school year after the 2s have transitioned to their school day.

3s Classes (page 6): Children may attend class four mornings (Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday) or five mornings per week. Classes meet from 9:00 am until 1:00 pm or from 9:00 am until 2:30 pm with the Extended Day option. Lunch time is included in both schedules, and you will be asked to pack your child a kosher-style lunch.

Pre-K/4s Classes (page 8): Children may attend 5 mornings per week from 9:00 am – 1:00 pm or from 9:00 am until 2:30 pm with the Extended Day option. Lunch time is included in both schedules, and you will be asked to pack your child a kosher-style lunch.

Early Drop-off (page 4, 6 or 8, depending on age): Children enrolled in the 2s, 3s, and 4s classes may begin their day at 8:30 am. (This option is not available for our Toddlers Together class students.)

Priority Registration Schedule and Dates

1. Current ECEP families and/or Temple members – January 11, 2021 through January 22, 2021 (Families who were waitlisted or enrolled in the 2020-2021 school year but were not able to attend may register from January 19, 2021 through January 22, 2021.)
2. Former ECEP families who are not Temple members – January 25, 2021 through January 27, 2021
3. Open enrollment period – begins January 27, 2021, first come, first served

If a family misses the deadline for its priority registration group, we will process the registration materials in the next group for which it is eligible. There will be no exceptions.

2021-2022 Tuition Payment Agreement

Sibling Discount: A 10% discount is offered when two or more siblings are enrolled in any Temple Sinai Early Childhood Education Program class. The highest tuition of the enrolled siblings will be allocated at full tuition and each successive child will receive a 10% discount.

Tuition Deposit: A \$750.00 tuition deposit is required at the time of registration and will be applied to the final tuition invoice. For withdrawals from the program before April 2, 2021 (or once we are in receipt of a signed contract), a refund minus a \$300 administrative fee will be offered. On or after April 2, 2021, no refunds of this tuition deposit will be permitted. Tuition deposits may be remitted by check or credit card (credit card users are subject to a 2.5% surcharge) or paid through the Temple website.

Tuition Refund and Withdrawal Policy:

- Tuition payments begin on June 15, 2021. If payment is not received by this date or within 1 week of registration, we cannot guarantee your child's enrollment.
- Tuition payments are non-refundable after their due dates. In extraordinary cases in which a family relocates and it is no longer possible to attend the ECEP, consideration for a pro-rated refund will be made on a case-by-case basis. No refunds will be made for withdrawals after April 1, 2022.
- We are unable to offer make-up classes for individual days missed by your child.
- Any request for a reduction in the number of days or classes that your child will attend should be made in writing and received by May 28, 2021.
- All requests for withdrawals must be made in writing.

Tuition Refunds in the Event of Closures due to COVID:

- If the ECEP or Temple Sinai is required to close for a COVID-related reason, we will quickly move to virtual learning/gathering using one or a combination of online platforms. These gatherings will be important to maintain and deepen the relationships between children and teachers while the building is closed, allowing for a smoother transition when the ECEP can re-open in person. The frequency, duration and content of the virtual gatherings will be determined by ECEP teachers and administration based on what is considered best practice and developmentally appropriate for each age group.
- In the event of a school closure of greater than 4 weeks, you will have the option to continue or withdraw from the ECEP's virtual learning opportunities.
- Should you choose to continue with virtual learning, you will receive a refund of 50% of the pro-rated tuition for the remainder of the closure.
- You may choose to withdraw from virtual learning and the ECEP at any point after the first 4 weeks of closure; you are expected to notify the ECEP, in writing, at least 2 weeks prior to withdrawal. You will receive a pro-rated refund for the remaining school year. Should we re-open in person, Temple Sinai may provide an option for families to re-enroll or for new families to enroll if space permits.
- Temple Sinai reserves the right to modify or discontinue virtual learning during an extended closure. The cancellation of virtual learning will result in a pro-rated refund for the remainder of the closure.

Tuition Payment Plans: Please check your desired plan. A 3% late fee may be applied to tuition payments made after their due date.

- Early Plan:** Payment in full (100%) by June 15, 2021. There is a 2.0% discount off the total tuition (excluding deposit) if tuition is paid by cash or check.
- Regular Plan:** Payment in 3 installments: 40% of tuition due by June 15, 2021, 30% of tuition due by September 15, 2021, and balance of tuition due by December 15, 2021. (The \$750 tuition deposit will be applied to the December 15 invoice.) Rates as listed on Tuition Schedule. If tuition payments are made by credit card, there is a 2.5% credit card surcharge.
- Scheduled Monthly Payment Plan:** Scheduled monthly payments (by credit card or eCheck) in 7 monthly installments are as follows - 20% of tuition due by June 15, 2021, 20% due by July 15, 2021, 20% due by August 15, 2021, and 10% due by the fifteenth of each month from September through December 2021). There is a 2.5% credit card surcharge on the Scheduled Monthly Payment Plan.
