Dear Prospective Family,

We appreciate your interest in the Early Childhood Education Program (ECEP) at Temple Sinai. Our program includes Toddler & Me (a child-caregiver class), Toddlers Together (a school-readiness “transition” drop-off class), and school classes for 2-, 3-, and 4-year-olds. We also offer our Summer Sensations camp program for 2-, 3-, and 4-year-olds. These classes take place in our beautifully renovated classrooms, and the children have use of all Temple facilities – the playground, Mud Kitchen and other outdoor play and learning spaces, the sanctuary and chapel, the library, and the kitchen. Temple Sinai is situated in the historic Todd mansion, and that “homey” feeling is evident wherever you walk, both indoors and outdoors.

Choosing a program that fits your child’s and family’s needs is an important decision. At Temple Sinai’s ECEP, we understand that children are born with the curiosity, ability, and the desire to learn about their world and the people in it. Your child will be part of an active learning environment that will inspire creativity, imagination, and the love of learning! Equally important, you will become part of the Temple Sinai community, a community that is motivated to support the social, emotional, academic, and spiritual journey that you are beginning with your child. Lifelong friendships for children and adults are formed at Temple Sinai’s ECEP. As an added benefit, Temple membership is **included** in full-year class tuition for those families whose oldest child is in Kindergarten or below. For those who are interested in membership and whose oldest child is in 1st or 2nd grade, Temple Sinai offers a reduced annual family membership rate. More details are on the attached registration form.

Our program is a research-based program that incorporates the best practices from a variety of different educational approaches. We use both child-centered and teacher-guided instruction; our teachers design curriculum to teach developmentally appropriate skills based on themes that emerge during classroom discussions and interactions. This type of “emergent” curriculum allows children with all learning styles to move through skills mastery at their own pace, using materials and activities that interest them. The lesson plans will differ from class to class and year to year, with the important age-level skills (social, cognitive, language, and physical) always at the core.

We invite you to visit and observe the rich and creative experiences your child will have. We are happy to meet with you individually for a tour of the Temple and to answer any questions you may have about the program. 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Early Childhood Education Program Philosophy

At Temple Sinai's Early Childhood Education Program, we understand that children are born with the curiosity, ability, and desire to learn about their world and the people in it. Our job as educators is to create opportunities for children to explore and learn in safe and developmentally appropriate environments. We believe in the importance of children's engaging with peers, teachers, and classroom materials in ways that meet the needs and pace of each individual child. Our students are supported in all areas of their development -- cognitive, physical, social-emotional, and language. Our teachers model critical life skills, including the social/communicative skills necessary to succeed in everyday social interactions. They also create classroom environments that encourage children to become thinkers and problem-solvers and to guide their own learning experiences. Finally, the ECEP supports young children and their families in beginning their Jewish journey together, with friends, and with their community.

The mission of Temple Sinai's Early Childhood Education Program is to:

- provide genuine, safe, and exciting new experiences for young children and their families;
- promote positive self-esteem and a strong sense of Jewish identity;
- foster lifelong friendships within our nurturing community;
- create an active and interactive learning environment for children, parents, and staff;
- inspire creativity, imagination, and love of learning in every child;
- celebrate our world and its diversity; and,
- support children in their natural development from "me" to "we."



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CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Pre-K/4s Classes

Children may attend 4 mornings (Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday) or 5 mornings per week from 9:00 am – 1:00 pm. Lunch time is included, and you will be asked to pack your child a kosher-style lunch.

3s and 4s “... and More” Extended Day program

Children attending our 3s or 4s program may stay from 1:00 – 2:30 pm for a continuation of our skills-based morning curriculum in a multi-age setting. After a short rest time, children will use open-ended materials to strengthen the age-appropriate skills being developed during their morning classes. Activities will be based on the interests of the children in the class and, depending on the day, will focus on developing skills in literacy, math, STEM, art, music and movement, drama, **...and More!** Children will also participate in gross motor play, either outdoors in the Temple backyard (including the playground and Mud Kitchen) or indoors, depending on the weather. 3s/4s Extended Day program begins approximately 2 weeks into the school year.

Your child may join us for 1 to 5 days of this exciting new program. No two days will be the same!

Monday: Science... and More!

Tuesday: Language/Literacy... and More!

Wednesday: Dramatic Play and Movement... and More!

Thursday: Fine Motor Development... and More!

Friday: Math Play... and More!

(Please note: Children are not required to sleep during rest time – they will rest while listening to music, reading books, or listening to stories. Children will rest on individual mats, and you will be asked to send a crib-sized sheet or blanket to cover the mat. Rest sheets will be sent home each week for washing.)

Early Drop-off

Children enrolled in the 2s, 3s, and 4s classes may begin their day at 8:30 am. (This option is not available for our toddler class students.)

**** Our classes require a minimum number of enrolled children in order to proceed.**



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Priority Registration Schedule and Dates

1. Current ECEP families and/or Temple members – January 2, 2019 through January 11, 2019
2. Former ECEP families who are not Temple members – January 14, 2019 through January 16, 2019
3. Grandchildren of Temple members – January 17, 2019 through January 21, 2019
4. Open enrollment period – begins January 22, 2019, first come, first served

If a family misses the deadline for its priority registration group, we will process the registration materials in the next priority registration group for which it is eligible. There will be no exceptions.

** Decisions about daily Early Drop-off and Extended Day will be made (based on enrollment) on or around May 15th, 2019.

Notes:

1. We reserve the right to add, cancel or combine classes based on enrollment. If the minimum enrollment is not met, all money will be refunded.
2. Exceptions to birth date deadlines are rare and are handled on a case-by-case basis.
3. Daily attendance for Early Drop-off and Enrichment may be considered based on enrollment and staffing numbers. The costs will be as follows: Early Drop-off - \$10/day, 2s Lunch or Enrichment - \$15/day, 2s Lunch + Enrichment - \$25/day, 3s/4s Extended Day - \$25/day.

(Membership dues will be included in the tuition price of full-year ECEP classes. This offer does not apply to Toddler & Me half-year programs or to enrichment programs.) Temple membership remains active through June 30, 2020 for families enrolled in good standing.

Families with Young Children/Young Couple Membership: For families who are interested in temple membership and whose oldest child is in 1st or 2nd grade, Temple Sinai is happy to offer a reduced annual rate. 2019-2020 Tuition Payment Agreement

Sibling Discount: A 10% discount is offered when two or more siblings are enrolled in any Temple Sinai Early Childhood Education Program class. The highest tuition of the enrolled siblings will be allocated at full tuition and each successive child will receive a 10% discount.

Tuition Deposit: A \$750.00 tuition deposit is required at the time of registration and will be applied to the final tuition invoice. For withdrawals from the program before March 1, 2019 (or once we are in receipt of a signed contract), a refund minus a \$300 administrative fee will be offered. On or after March 1, 2019, no refunds of this tuition deposit will be permitted. Tuition deposits may be remitted by check or credit card (credit card users are subject to a 2.5% surcharge) or paid through the Temple website.

Tuition Refund and Withdrawal Policy:

- Tuition payments begin on June 1st, 2019. If payment is not received by this date, we cannot guarantee your child's enrollment.
- Tuition payments are non-refundable after their due dates. In extraordinary cases in which a family relocates and it is no longer possible to attend the ECEP, consideration for a pro-rated refund will be made on a case-by-case basis. No refunds will be made for withdrawals after April 1, 2020.
- There will be no credits or make-up classes for time missed for sick days, doctors' appointments, vacations/holidays, or weather-related closures.
- Any request for a reduction in the number of days or classes that your child will attend must be made in writing and received by May 31, 2019. After that date, there will be no changes to tuition payments owed.
- All requests for withdrawals should be made in writing at least thirty (30) days in advance.

Tuition Payment Plans: Please check your desired plan. A 3% late fee may be applied to tuition payments made after their due date.

- Early Plan:** Payment in full (100%) by June 1, 2019. There is a 2.5% discount off the total tuition (excluding deposit) if tuition is paid by cash or check.
- Regular Plan:** Payment in 3 installments: 40% of tuition due by June 1, 2019, 30% of tuition due by September 1, 2019, and balance of tuition due by December 1, 2019. (The \$750 tuition deposit will be applied to the December 1st invoice.) Rates as listed on Tuition Schedule. If tuition payments are made by credit card, there is a 2.5% credit card surcharge.
- Scheduled Monthly Payment Plan:** Scheduled monthly payments by credit card in 8 monthly installments, (20% of tuition due by June 1, 2019, 20% due by July 1, 2019, and 10% due by the first day of the month from August 2019 through January 1, 2020). There is a 2.5% credit card surcharge on the Scheduled Monthly Payment Plan.

I have read and accept the above tuition payment plan and other registration policies, including deposit, refund/withdrawal, membership and immunization policies.
