1. **October 6 - November 17, K-7:** NEW Warm Clothing Items for our Neighbors at Jersey Battered Women's Shelter: **hats, gloves/mittens, scarves, socks** (all sizes: infants to teens, all new)

2. **November 3, K-7:** **Thanksgiving Foods** for local Neighbors through IFPO (Interfaith Food Pantry) Please drop off your donations in the first floor lobby.

**Thanksgiving Canned/Boxed/Non-perishable Items:** Corn, Canned Vegetables, Instant Mashed Potatoes, Stuffing mix, Gravy, Canned Yams, Brown Sugar, Crushed Pineapple, Mini-marshmallows Cranberry sauce, Cake mixes, Icing, Pudding mixes, AND/OR \$20 donation toward a family turkey

3. **November 17, K-2 Academy:** Fresh foods to assemble fresh lunches on 11/17 for our homeless Neighbors in Irvington, through Summit's *Bridges* organization. (Watch for Sign-Up-Genius)

4. **December 8, K-7:** **Nutritious foods, baby diapers, new toys** for our Neighbors through IFPO  
**Requested Items:** tuna, hearty soups, beans, rice, baby diapers, household detergents, toys (toddler-13)

5. **December 15, Grade 7:** Families donate ingredients that grade 7 students will use to cook a meal for 20 Neighbors, to be served at SHIP (Summit Helping Its People). We'll also need 3 volunteer families to serve the meal to hungry neighbors around 3pm. (Watch for Sign-Up-Genius)

6. **January 26, Grade 3:** Families donate "sustainable foods" to assemble lunches on 1/26 for *Bridges* to deliver to homeless Neighbors. (Watch for Sign-Up-Genius)

7. **February 9, K-2 Academy:** Families donate children's birthday party supplies for our Neighbors through the "Family-to-Family" organization's Birthday Giving Project.

**Requested Items:** hats/blowers; party paper goods; cake mixes, icing, candles, balloons, new gifts (girls/boys toys or books or clothing items, ages 5-8)
