Construction Plans Approved at Beit Olamim, Madison's Jewish Cemetery

On April 8, 2019, the City Council Planning Commission voted unanimously to approve the Jewish Burial Association of Madison's (JBAM) plans to build a driveway that enters Sunset Memory Gardens cemetery off of Westfield Road. The driveway will provide direct access to Beit Olamim, Madison's Jewish cemetery, and connect to the other inner driveways of the cemetery, facilitating easy access to families and visitors. The driveway and its landscaping are expected to be completed by fall. JBAM also is initiating its landscaping plan this summer, to beautify the cemetery and to help it continue to serve the Jewish community as a tranquil,

beautiful, and holy place. The landscape includes beautiful flowers, shrubs, and trees, as well as pavers to further help visitors move around the cemetery. Please come visit the cemetery to see how it has developed.
