

COVID-19 GUIDELINES

The YIS Campus is Mask Optional for Fully Vaccinated Individuals Only. The option not to wear masks applies only to **FULLY VACCINATED INDIVIDUALS**. Individuals are only considered “fully vaccinated” once they are two weeks or more removed from the final dose of a COVID-19 vaccine series. Individuals (including children) who do not meet this criteria (even if they have antibodies, recently had COVID-19 or for any other reason) must continue to wear masks on shul grounds unless eating at a program/activity involving food. **We are operating on the “honor system” and by not wearing a mask at shul you are representing to your fellow congregants that you are fully vaccinated.**

Again, we support anyone who chooses to continue to wear a mask at shul even if no longer required and you are welcome to do so. It would be entirely inappropriate and contrary to our community focus on Ahavat Yisroel for anyone to be criticized if they choose to continue to wear a mask at shul.
