## **ROSH HASHANA**

Rosh Hashana 5777 witnessed the Shul once again arrayed in pristine white, from the Poroches, down to the carpeting, and extending to each and every seat box. Many thanks to Mr. Victor Sussman and his able crew for the enormous amount of work inherent in the Shul's "KaShelleg Yalbinu" transformation, and all the other preparations necessary for the Yomim Noroim in Shul. As is our custom, the Shul remained "in white" throughout the Aseres Yemei Teshuva.



Between the various Ba'alei Tefilla, the Tefillos of the day, truly the focal point of the Yomim Noroim, were given the dignity and beauty that they deserve. Chazon Ezra Lasdun and Mr. Michael Gutmann davened Maariv on the first and second nights, respectively. Shacharis of Yom Aleph was led by Mr. Pinchas Katzenstein and that of Yom Beis by Mr. Theodore Levi. Chazon Lasdun davened Musaf on both days. Mincha on the two afternoons was davened by Messrs. Samson Bechhofer and Michael Gutmann, respectively. A grateful Kehilla acknowledges the tremendous amount of work and care put in by all our Chazonim, Baalei Keriah and Baalei Tekiah, as well as the choir and Synagogue Committee, to ensure the proper sanctity of these days. At the same time, we extend our thanks to all the gentlemen who led the daily Selichos, both before Rosh HaShana and during the Aseres Yemei Teshuva. These included (in alphabetical order) Messrs. Mr. Victor Sussman and Chazon Ezra Hes officiated as Baalei Keriah on the two respective days. Messrs. Jacob Lowenthal and Ben Ettlinger shared the Shofar blowing. The first day's Shofar was preceded by the Ray's speaking, giving insight into the Kolos HaShofar.

Many thanks to the gentlemen and boys for their Shofar-blowing at the hospital, nursing home and for the homebound. Likewise, we thank the young ladies of our Kehilla who so generously gave of their time to the babysitting service offered to young mothers on Rosh Hashana and Yom Kippur; many thanks to Rebbetzin Mantel who personally organized this service once again.

#### SHABBOS SHUVO AND ASERES YEMEI TESHUVA

Rav Mantel gave the Shabbos Shuvo Drosho before Musaf. Beginning with one of the lesser-known Roshei Teivos hints to Elul, אָר לַ לֵּךְ לַּמשנה, the Rav discussed the idea of our being, keveyochol, partners with HaShem. The Rav enumerated a number of areas in which Chazal describe us as Shutfim with HaKodosh Boruch Hu. The Rav urged the Kehilla to be mischazeik in those very areas, including Emuna, Emes, the Ruchniyus of one's children and Tzedoko.

In the afternoon after Mincha, Rav Mantel delivered the pilpul derosho on the subject of 'החיוב שהסכה תהי'. שיוכל לעשות שם כל צרכיו.

The bochurim of our Yeshiva Gedola, with Rav Rubanowitz at their head, were present for both deroshos.

#### **YOM KIPPUR**

Yom Kippur was observed by our Kehilla in its awesome solemnity. We again owe a debt of gratitude for the many hours spent in preparation by Chazon Lasdun, all our Ba'alei Tefilla and the choir, ensuring the Tefillos received the respect they deserve.

Chazon Lasdun davened Kol Nidrei-Maariv and Mussaf. Mr. Michael Gutmann led Shacharis and Rabbi Raphael Weis davened Mincha. Rav Mantel concluded the day's Tefillos with Ne'ila. Thanks as well to the Ba'alei Kri'oh, Rabbi Dr. Johny Hellmann and Chazon Ezra Hes. Rav Mantel spoke after Kol Nidrei.

The Rav also spoke briefly before Ne'ila, giving two explanations for the pasuk's words, "Shuva Elai **Ki** Ge'alticho:" At the end of Yom Kippur one should not feel despair for what he may have done in the past, for HaShem has saved him from all of it because he did Teshuva: "Return to Me", says HaShem, "**for** I have redeemed you." However, after Yom Kippur one must also not feel a misplaced complacency or confidence: "Always return to Me, **although** I just recently redeemed you!"

## **SUKKOS**

With the complement of unseasonably warm (and mainly **dry**) weather towards the beginning of Sukkos, our Kehilla celebrated Z'man Simchoseinu with much enthusiasm. Even with some chillier and raw weather over Shabbos Chol HaMoed, most meals were able to be eaten in the Sukkah.

Our Kehilla once again provided two large and attractive Sukkos for the use of members and other locals. The Sukkos were decorated with the artistic contributions of our Elementary School students. The Kehilla also provided tasteful decorations and posters in each of the Sukkos as well; many thanks to Mr. Avram Gutmann for his efforts in this aspect of "Zeh Keili VeAnveihu." We also thank the young men who helped in the building of the Sukkos. The Sukkah on the large playground was used for catered meals on the Yom Tov days, provided by Lechayim Caterers; many thanks to Mr. Yitzy Dyckman. A number of men and boys also slept in the Sukkos, for which the Kehilla arranged overnight security.



Among those who ensured that Sukkos was celebrated as a "Chag *Kosher* v'Some'ach" are Rabbi L. Leslie Weis and family who once again provided the opportunity to purchase Arba'ah Minim and Hoshanos. To say the least, this is neither an easy nor simple task, and the Kehilla salutes them.

In our Yeshiva, the students prepared for Sukkos in various, most enjoyable, ways.





Chazon Lasdun led the Tzibur in all the Tefillos and Hoshanos of the Yom Tov days as well as Shabbos Chol HaMoed and Hoshana Rabba morning. Rav Mantel gave the Yom Tov lecture after Mincha on the second day of Yom Tov, discussing the palpably different feelings of the Yomim Noroim, vs. Sukkos and some of the ideas behind this.

On the afternoon of Shabbos Chol HaMoed, the Kehilla enjoyed the now-annual Shabbos Chol HaMoed Sukkos Seudoh Shlishis. Rav Mantel delivered a D'var Halacha on the topic of Hidur Mitzva, and Zemiros were sung.

On the second evening of Chol HaMoed, Thursday, October 20th, the gentlemen and boys of the Kehilla enjoyed the annual Simchas Beis HaSho'eva in the Kehilla Sukkah. Rav Mantel spoke and there was music (provided by the very talented Yaakov Rubanowitz), dancing and refreshments.









Providing more spiritual fare for the Yom Tov, Shiurim were one again held on the weekdays of Chol HaMoed, in the Beis Medrash. This was, as usual, arranged by Rabbi Chaim Aschkenasy, whom we thank. The Magidei Shiur were Rabbi Avrohom Moshe Seidman and Rabbi Yakov Geldwerth.

The Pirchei and B'nos groups of Washington Heights, under the leadership of, respectively, Rabbi Menachem Kunofsky and Misses Rochel Leah Gordimer and Ruchama Klugmann, enjoyed some Chol HaMoed fun, on separate outings. The Bnos trip produced a near-record turnout of over sixty girls from the tri-state area.

On Hoshana Rabba night the men and boys gathered in Moller Hall for the learning and Rav Mantel spoke to the assembled.



#### SHEMINI ATZERES AND SIMCHAS TORAH

Beginning with the Pizmonim Kaddish of Shemini Atzeres Mincha and continuing throughout Simchas Torah in the Tefillos, Duchanen, Kerias HaTorah, extending all the way through An'im Zemiros and Adon Olam, the full Yahres-selection of tunes was rendered. As was mentioned during the Simchas Torah Party, we owe a tremendous debt of gratitude to Chazon Lasdun and the other Baalei Tefilla, as well as to the choir.

Chazon Lasdun led most of the days' Tefillos; Messrs. Samson Bechhofer and Michael Gutmann davened Mincha of the two days.

On Shemini Atzeres Rav and Rebbetzin Mantel hosted the Matnas Yad reception, allowing a grateful Kehilla to thank the Rav for the Berochos bestowed upon them that morning, and to fulfill the dictum of Chazal (Rosh Hashana 16:), to greet one's Rav on Yom Tov.

The evening and morning of Simchas Torah saw spirited Hakofos and dancing. Special thanks to the following gentlemen who helped Chazon Lasdun and led some of the Hakofos: Messrs. Yossi Basker, Chaim Gordimer, Eli Hutman, and Yosef Levi and Rabbis Ronny Levy and Kalman Strauss. In the evening it was Messrs. Samson Bechhofer and Dovie Lomnitz dancing with Chazon Lasdun and the Sifrei Torah, while in the morning Messrs. Alan Ettlinger and Avram Cahn did the honors.

The Simchas Torah Party took place in Moller Hall after Mincha. The dais was graced by Rav Mantel, as well as the Chassanim of both the main and Hashkama Minyanim, among others, and Zemiros were sung. Mr. Ettlinger both emceed as well as gave the annual "State of the Kehilla" address. Quoting Rav Hirsch, he noted that looking back on past accomplishments should only be done as a means of encouraging ourselves for future endeavors. Mr. Ettlinger mentioned the strategic planning that is necessary, and will IYH be done, to ensure that our Kehilla and Yeshiva remain vibrant and grow. Mr. Ettlinger also expressed his praise and thanks to our Rabbanim and to all the various people and groups who work on the Kehilla's behalf. Mr. Avram Cahn, on behalf of the Kehilla's Board, extended thanks to Mr. Ettlinger himself for his tireless dedication to the Kehilla, both in his capacity as president and member of the Synagogue Committee.

In his address, Rav Mantel connected the phrases in Atta Bechartanu to each of the seven Ushpizin, urging their influence to not only be felt on Sukkos, but in our daily lives the year round.

Both Rav Mantel and Mr. Ettlinger enumerated the praises of Rabbi Yosef Lasdun, Chosson Bereishis of the main minyan, and the Lasdun family. Rabbi Lasdun was the final speaker of the day.

At this point, KAJN takes the opportunity to wish all the Chassanei Torah and Bereishis a hearty Mazel Tov. We hope and pray that all the Brochos bestowed upon them come to fruition.

## **NEW TRANSLATION OF RAV POSEN'S SEFER**

The Kehilla continues to wish Rav Jacob Posen שליט"א a hearty mazel tov on the occasion of the publication of his newest sefer, *Kitzur Hilchos Shabbos*, the English translation to his קיצור הלכות שבת. The new sefer comprises 670 pages and has the Hebrew and English side-by-side on facing pages. It also includes a corrected version of the מקורות (sources) of each Halacha.

It was more than forty years ago that Rav Posen took the manuscript to the Gaon Rav Moshe Feinstein ל"ד to look at it. At that time, Rav Moshe told Rav Posen that the sefer should be translated into English, the vernacular of the majority of Yidden in America. The translated sefer—printed in Eretz Yisroel—has finally been completed and is now available in the States. In his הסכמה to the translation, Rav Dovid Feinstein שליט"א writes "[....this translation] is of great benefit in this country, where many of those who seek the Word of Hashem know only this language..."

Therefore, it is forbidden to wear any man's, woman's or child's garment that contains wool or linen until it has been determined not to contain *shaatnez*. To determine whether your garment is *shaatnez*-free, garments may be dropped off at the Kehilla office, 714 W. 186<sup>th</sup> Street at the following times:
