

Moadim Perspectives: Sefirah—Fast Days—Tu B'Shevat; Consolation and Faith.



And on the personal days of mourning, Shivah and Yahrzeit — days of painful remembrance of our losses — reflection on the past in the light of our absolute faith, Emunah, brings consolation to the present and inspiration for the future.
