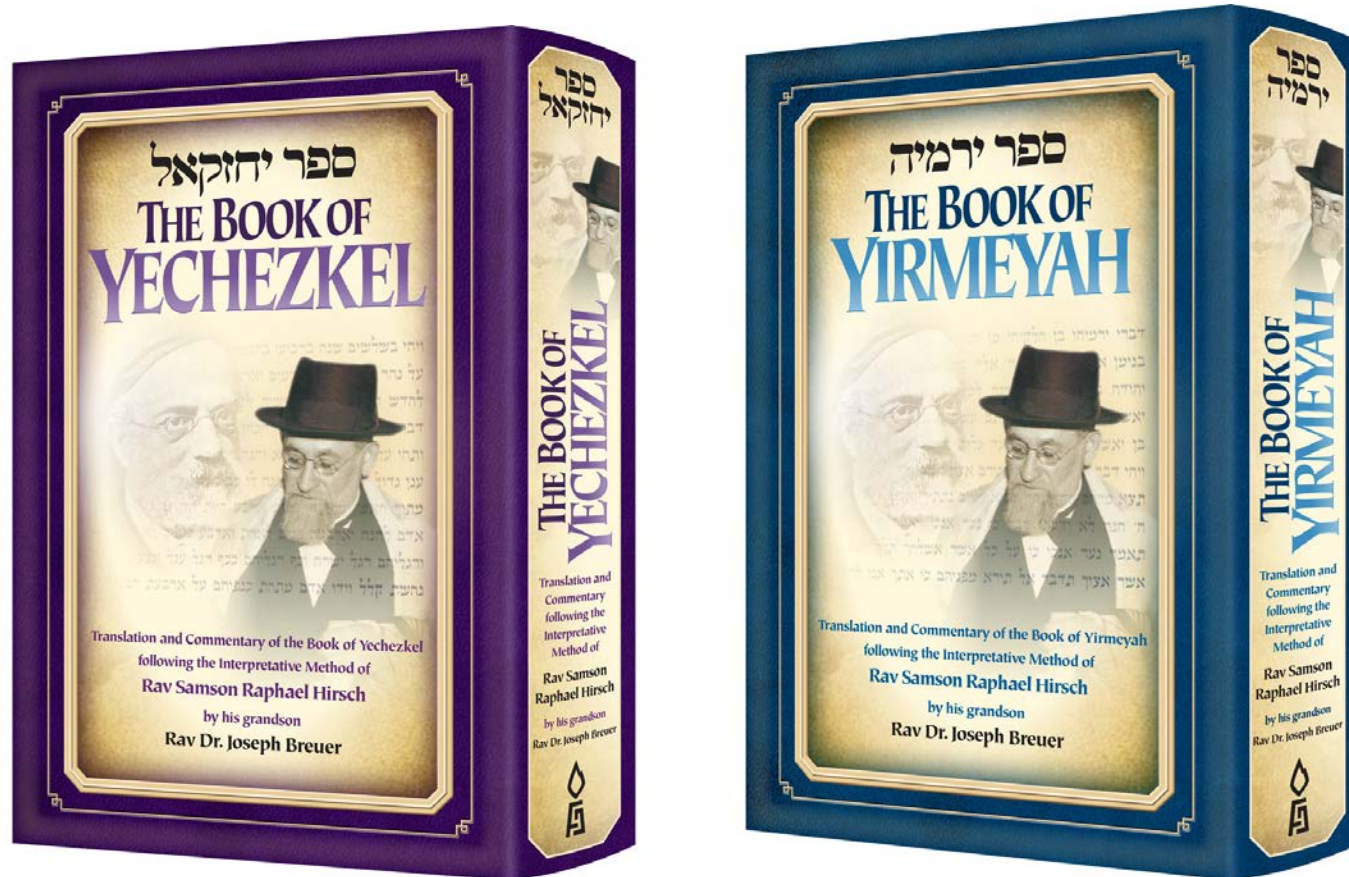

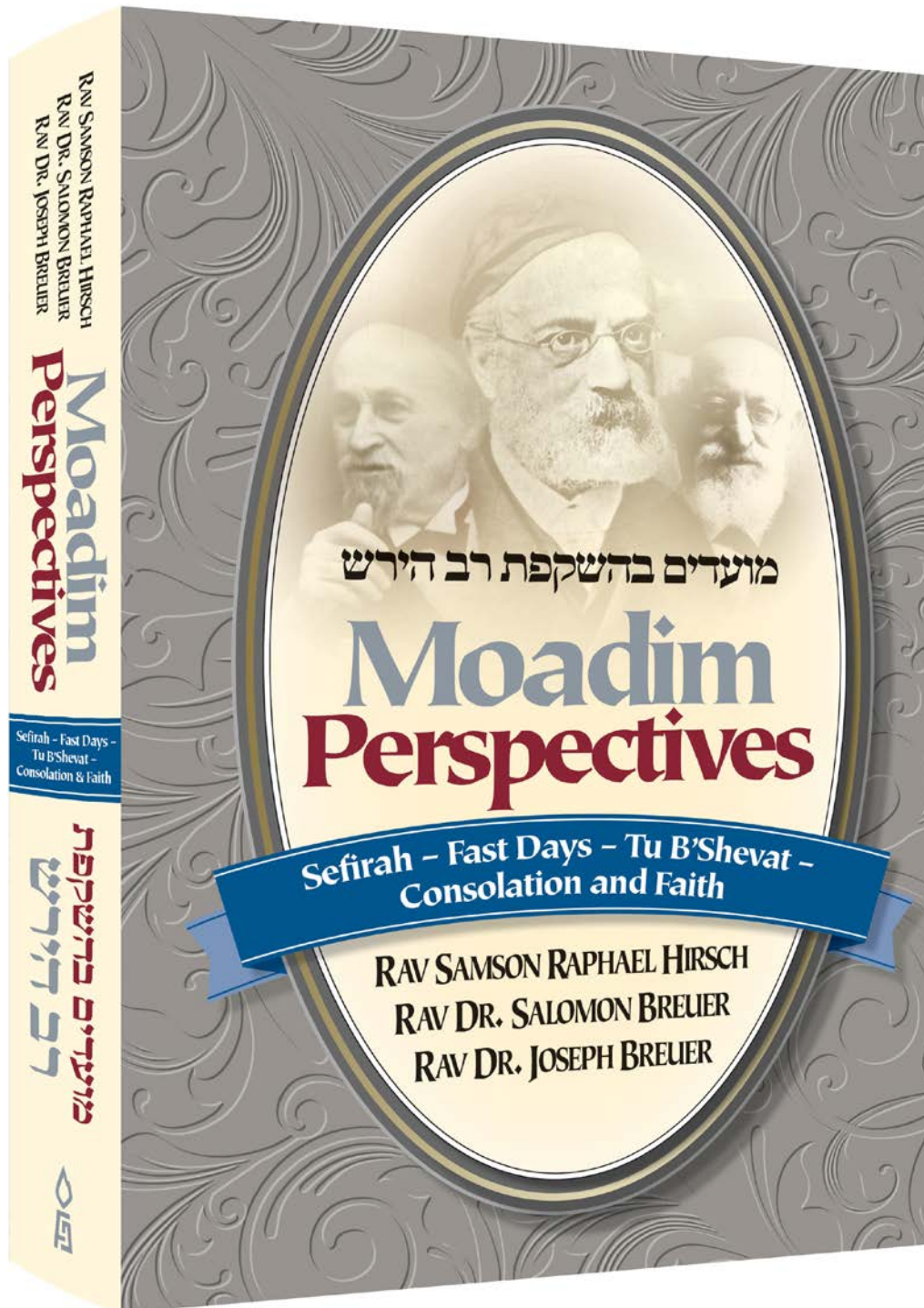
are now again available. These are classic works which enhance our study and understanding of *Nevi'im*.

And on the personal days of mourning, Shivah and Yahrzeit — days of painful remembrance of our losses — reflection on the past in the light of our absolute faith, Emunah, brings consolation to the present and inspiration for the future.
