Agudath Israel of America is now accepting "Early Bird Reservations" for the upcoming Siyum Daf Yomi to be held at Met Life Stadium on January 1, 2020.

The Kehilla will be reserving a block of tickets which will allow you to be seated together with the other members of the Kehilla and their families. If you wish to join our group and be seated with other Washington Heights Lomdei HaDaf, please contact Johny Hellmann as soon as possible to make a reservation.

While ticket prices at the event will range from \$25 to \$1,800 per seat, the Kehilla will be reserving the \$25 and \$100 seats (only). If you wish to purchase at another price you may do so directly with the Agudah. Please be sure to specify how many Men's and how many Ladies' tickets you wish to purchase. You may call 212-923-5926 or email johny.hellmann@gmail.com but please remember that **you must provide payment in full with your reservation**. Early-bird reservations will be accepted until **August 11th**. Checks should be made out to Agudath Israel of America.

In addition, please indicate if you wish to avail yourself of a group bus. If we have enough participants, we will attempt to secure a reasonably priced bus service. At that time we will be requesting payment with your reservation.

The critical comment period for the State Education Department's proposed regulations regarding "substantial equivalency of instruction" is nearly halfway complete. We have 30 days left to write letters in protest of these proposed regulations. The Board of Regents is required by law to read every comment sent to them during this period. Every letter counts! To make a real impact on whether chinuch decisions in NYS will be decided by Albany, or by our rabbanim, principals, and parents, **we need to send a clear message of tens of thousands of comments to the Board of Regents.**

When the issue first emerged last year, it was fresh and shocking. **90,000** people signed an online petition. That petition is no longer of value. In the current round, there are not enough personal messages.

We, as a community, need to do better!

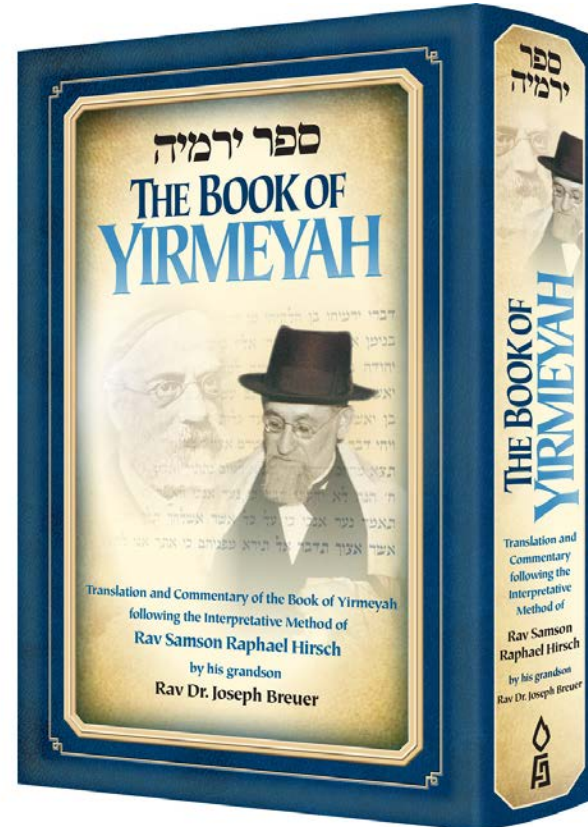
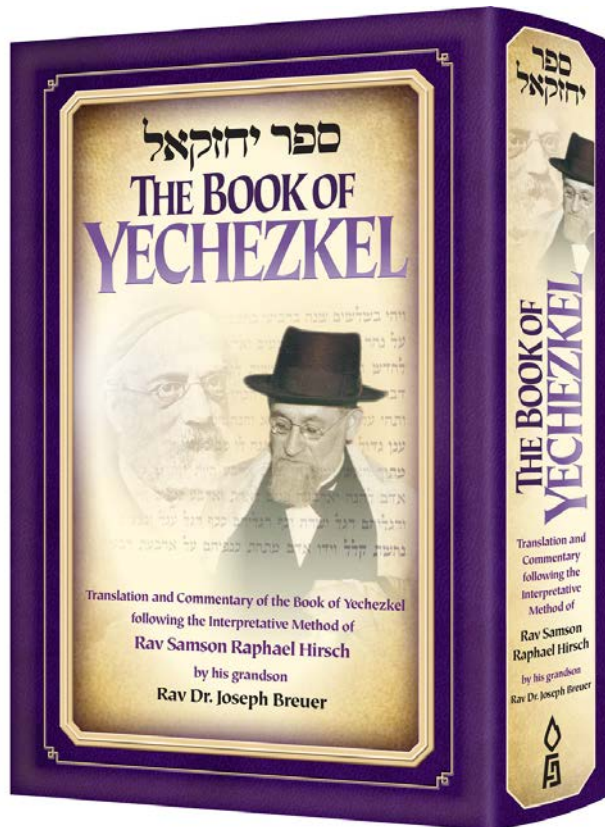
