Dutch Railway Compensation

Holocaust survivors and the families or heirs of Holocaust victims, who were transported to concentration and extermination camps during World War II by Nederlandse Spoorwegen (NS), the Dutch state railway company, may be eligible to receive a lump-sum payment.

The deadline to submit the electronic application is **August 5, 2020**.
