Free kosher "grab and go" meals under the supervision of the Volover Rov, approved by our Rabbinate, will be available, courtesy of New York City, Monday through Friday, for all, in Washington Heights at P.S. 048 P.O. Michael J. Buczek, 4360 Broadway (near West 186 Street), 10033.

Meals Hubs will operate for children and families from 7:30 am to 11:30 am, and for adults from 11:30 am to 1:30 pm and follow the guidelines below:

- No one will be turned away at any time
- All adults and children can pick up multiple meals at one time
- No dining space is available, so meals must be eaten off premises
- Parents and guardians may pick up meals for their children
- No registration or ID required


