Moments of joy and elevation were instantly transformed into tragedy for the chassidim of Karlin-Stolin in Eretz Yisroel.

Incredible efforts and resources were invested in making the entire area safe and secure for the thousands who were gathered. But the terrible decree had been sealed.

Two precious souls have lost their lives in the immediate moments of the crush.

Tens more remain hospitalized in critical condition—with years of rehabilitation ahead of them, in the optimistic circumstance. Many of them will require surgeries and medical care not covered by government insurance.

In addition to a fund that is needed to support the young widow and her daughter, the chassidus (which is not known for its material wealth) must put together astronomical sums to tend to the hundreds of families and individuals throughout the community that have just endured the impossible.

Klal Yisroel—which is feeling the pain and the shocking grief of the Karlin-Stoliner chassidim—is galvanizing to support the Karlin-Stoliner chassidim who have been dealt such a crushing blow, one that will take years to recover from.
