As per the Mesivta administration, non-talmidim are barred from attending Mesivta minyanim. Therefore, effective Sunday, August 29, the first day of Selichos, Mincha Gedola on Sunday will be back in Shul (most weeks at 1:30). This change is permanent for the entire Mesivta school year.






