UPDATED NOTICE (9/7/20)

As with other Shuls around the world, protection against the COVID19 virus is requiring the implementation of changes to our normal routine and Minyonim. Our Shul is no exception. Some of these changes may be difficult but we are trying to work within the CDC and New York State guidelines and ask for your understanding as we try to ensure everyone’s safety.

- Anyone who comes into Shul must wear a mask covering both mouth and nose at all times. No exceptions!
- If you find it difficult to keep your face covered, please step outside
- Social distancing is required. To accomplish this only those with a confirmed seat reservation may enter the shul on Rosh Hashana and Yom Kippur:
 - For the men, there will be assigned seating. Your assigned seat may not be your usual paid-for seat. Please do not sit in any seat other than the one assigned.
 - We are attempting to accommodate all women – for both days - who have applied. Because of limited seating in the women’s section, available seats will be marked. Please do not sit in any seat other than one that is marked.
 - Availability of baby sitting on Rosh Hashanna or Yom Kippur is still being evaluated.
 - Shofar will be blown in Shul again at 12:20PM (approximately 15 minutes after Davening on the second day.) In addition, Shofar will be blown in Shul again 5 minutes both before Tehillim and before Mincha.
 - Seating in the downstairs ladies' section is severely limited and will be by registration only.
 - To ensure social distancing, parents are requested to keep children in their seats during blowing of all Kollos
 - Although home care aides may accompany a person to and from their seats, they should not remain in Shul for davening.

Please consider that if you receive a confirmation (yet to be sent) but do not come to Shul, you may be taking a seat away from. If you get a confirmation and cannot come, please email the office.

In addition:

- The Mikve will not be open for men on Erev Rosh Hashana, Erev Yom Kippur and Erev Sukkos
- Because the Beis Medrash Building will be restricting non-students from Minyonim, there will be a **Mincha Gedola in Shul from Sunday to Thursday.**

Seat confirmations will be emailed the week before Rosh Hashanna.

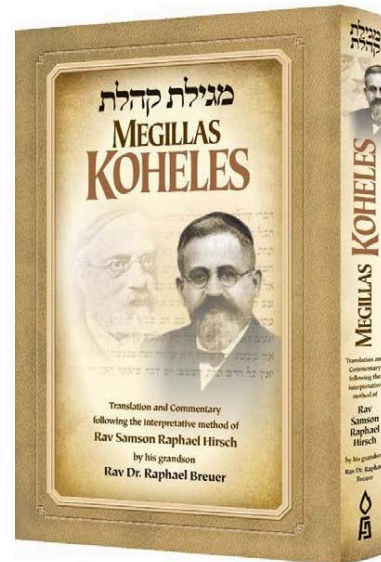
