The NYS Education Department recently released new, proposed Substantial Equivalency Regulations for nonpublic schools. These regulations give unprecedented authority over the Yeshivos to the local public-school districts, and the curricular requirements can present a serious challenge to the ability of Yeshivos to be mechanech our children according to our mesorah. The Moetzes Gedolei haTorah and Roshei Yeshiva of Torah Umesorah ask us to send a message opposing any change to our children's chinuch.
